

KSA PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE
October 10, 2007

The KSA Public Safety Committee met at the South Woodland Hills Community Room on Wednesday, October 10.

Officer Dwayne Ulrich presented the Houston Police Department crime report. September for South Woodland Hills:

The police emphasize that valuable property, such as computers, etc. not be visibly kept in a parked vehicle; cars parked overnight should be locked, and people should report crimes to the police as soon as possible.

If you are faced with an emergency situation, you should promptly call 911 for police, ambulance, or fire. In a non-emergency situation, call dispatch directly at 713-884-3131. Calling the Kingwood HPD station directly will result in a delayed response.

The Houston Fire Department did a presentation of the Zoll Auto Pulse CPR system, a new device that paramedics are using in Kingwood and throughout Houston in the event of a heart attack. It promises to be more effective than the standard CPR without the risk of broken ribs.

Fire Station 105 at West Lake Houston Pkwy. In Summerwood will be operational in December. It will provide backup for Kingwood when needed.
