

**KSA PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT  
TO THE SOUTH WOODLAND HILLS VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION  
November 18, 2007**

The KSA Public Safety Committee met at the South Woodland Hills Community Room on Wednesday, November 14.

Officer Dwayne Ulrich presented the Houston Police Department crime report for October. Data for South Woodland Hills and Kingwood are as follows

A tactical unit is being assembled to patrol Kingwood. This unit, consisting of a sergeant and six other officers, will be assigned to areas of particular concern, such as burglary of motor vehicles or whatever particular criminal activity is prevalent. Captain Montgomery has requested that the tactical unit be in place as soon as possible; it is expected to be operational about the end of November.

Staffing was discussed. The night shift has been particularly hard hit by a loss of personnel, currently 17 compared to 34 in 2000. In total, the Kingwood station has 69-70 officer assigned to it. This is compared to 88 officers assigned to Kingwood in 2001. At the present time, there is one bike patrolman on the evening shift (2:00 pm to 10:00 pm) and 6 bike patrolmen in the daytime shift (7:00 am to 3:00 pm).

The KSA Public Safety Committee will send a letter to the City of Houston requesting additional police officers be assigned to Kingwood.

The KSA Public Safety Committee voted to approve the expenditure of \$4,000 for holiday food to be delivered to the police and fire stations on Thanksgiving and Christmas days.

The Public safety Committee approved the expenditure of \$2,000 to purchase radio equipment for use by ham radio persons in the event of a major emergency that results in loss of communications via normal means. The equipment will be kept at the police station, but will remain the property of KSA.

Early voting for the District E council runoff election will be at the Kingwood library from November 29 to December 4. Election Day is Saturday, December 8.
