

**KSA PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT
TO THE SOUTH WOODLAND HILLS VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION
January 14, 2007**

The KSA Public Safety Committee met at the South Woodland Hills Community Room on Wednesday, January 9.

Officer Dwayne Ulrich presented the Houston Police Department crime report for December. Data for South Woodland Hills and Kingwood are as follows

A tactical unit is in place to patrol Kingwood. The overtime program and work by the tactical unit has resulted in a significant reduction in burglaries of motor vehicles in Kingwood, from a high of 62 in October to 51 in November and 19 in December.

There was considerable discussion of identity theft. People need to be very careful of personal information they give out, such as account numbers and social security numbers. If you suspect that your identity has been stolen, report it to the Houston Police Department. The Kingwood station has forms to fill out, and a police report needs to be filed. The police report is usually needed to get compensated for inappropriate charges to your accounts.
